Please note: Admission to TCU and declaration of a major in education are not synonymous with admission to the Teacher Education Program. Students who plan to major or minor in education and who plan to earn a teaching certificate, at the undergraduate or at the non-degree level, must apply for admission to the TCU College of Education.

To be eligible to apply for admission to the Teacher Education Program of TCU, students must meet, or will meet during the semester in which they apply, the following minimum requirements:

1. Complete a minimum of 54 semester hours of course work.
2. Attain an overall GPA of 2.75 on a minimum of 12 semester hours of course work at TCU.
3. Complete a course in each of the following areas of study, speech and EDUC 20003 (CI) with a grade of C or better.
4. Complete 12 hours of content area coursework.
5. Achieve a grade of C or better in all content area and education courses taken prior to admission.
6. Attach record of current (within one year) criminal record check.
7. Attach FERPA agreement.
8. Attach signed Ethics Statement or Certificate of Ethics Training.
9. Attach required scores (ACT and SAT scores must not be older than five years) on **one** of the following tests:

THEA/TASP: Reading 260; Math 230; Writing 220
ACT: Composite 23; Reading 19, Math 19
SAT: Composite 1570; 500 in Verbal, Math & Writing
