The Starpoint Associate Position is a Teaching Assistant (TA) position funded by the College of Education and Starpoint School. The position is a summer/fall/spring one-year appointment. The Associate receives 6 hours summer tuition; 6 hours fall tuition; 6 hours spring tuition and a stipend of \$15,000 for 20 hours of work per week at Starpoint School. The Director of Starpoint School assigns the Associate to work in individual classrooms at the school; such work may include assisting a teacher with planning, teaching/tutoring small groups of students, or similar duties. (Required education: Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood-Sixth Grade Program)
