To make graduate education more accessible to working students, the College of Education offers a limited number of "Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Grants" for part-time graduate students enrolled in credit courses. These grants are available to students with higher income brackets than are usually considered for federal financial assistance.

Amounts of Grants

TAP provides ¼ - ½ tuition credit for up to six credit hours each semester. A total of six hours is allowed for all summer sessions combined.

Income Limitations

In order to be eligible, the adjusted gross income may not exceed:

- \$75,705* for independent, single students without dependents
- \$93,955* for married students or single students with dependents *Note: TAP amounts are subject to change.

Qualifications

Applicants must be:

- Year-round full or part-time students
- Accepted to the University before the TAP application may be considered
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the U.S.
- In good academic and financial standing at all colleges and universities attended
